Tips to Help You Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle

You can make a difference to the environment right at home. Do your part this summer (and year-round!) to reduce waste, reuse items, and recycle what articles you can.

In the Home

- Donate non-perishable food to local food banks.
- Reuse items like rags, empty jars, and gift wrap.
- Recycle used tires by returning them to participating retailers.
- Recycle packaging and empty containers whenever possible.
- Set your thermostat a few degrees higher in the summer, and lower in the winter.
- Install compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs) when your old bulbs burn out.
- Buy items in bulk or concentrate - and in packaging made of recycled material when possible.

In the Yard

- Make compost at home and use it in your yard.
- Mow higher and leave the clippings.
- Choose plants native to your area.
- Let soil partially dry between watering.
- Borrow, rent or share tools that you don't use often.
